ABERGELE: WALES

Value: £300,000

Completed: November 2008

Description: The Environment Agency had a requirement to upgrade their existing pumping facility at Bodoryn, Wales.

Rigby and Partners role was to design and detail a new two tier weed screen, a steel access platform, inset concrete wet well, gabion retaining walls and associated slabs / ramps and general civil works.

UNITED UTILITIES: GRIMSARGH: PRESTON

Value :£175,000

Completed: December 2008

Description: United Utilities required the decommissioning of three reservoirs (95625m²) and opted to convert the reservoirs into a wildlife reserve / conservation area.

Rigby and Partners were required to design various slopes / embankments / cuttings with associated drainage details including trash screens & open dry weather flow channels.

GLAXO SMITHKLINE: COLEFORD

Description: Construction of a new lorry park at its Coleford site. The work included attenuated surface water drainage design in co-ordination with the Environment Agency and associated concrete yard design.

Anti-pollution valves were incorporated into the scheme.

The two storey building (3595m³) comprised a steel portal framed building with associated services.
